District 8 Legislator

District 8 Legislator Ron Lemon supports four year term for legislators, does not feel it is necessary to limit term limits, and is not in favor of downsizing or redistricting. He did talk to the County and they did clear out part of Mr. Costanzo's ditch on Peck Settlement Road.

Monthly Report

Town Clerk brought up about Kiantone residents requesting 911 address markers, Councilwoman McDonald had talked to a Kiantone resident about purchasing a green or blue reflective address marker, The Busti and Frewsburg Fire Departments are offering them. Councilwoman McDonald will look into the possibility of either of them working with Kiantone Residents who would like to purchase them. Supervisor Piazza made a motion to authorize Councilwoman McDonald to do this, seconded by Councilman Johnson. Yea-5 nay-0. Carried.

The Town Clerk has been working with the Census people who are verifying addresses and whether one or two family dwellings. The Town Clerk's office had got three bid proposals for carpeting for the entryway and office and had the lowest one install the carpeting.

Councilwoman McDonald brought up about the cleaning of the Community Building. Supervisor Piazza asked that a list of job description to let the custodian know what is to be cleaned and if there is anything she needs to assist her in doing her job. Councilwoman McDonald and the Town Clerk will come up with a job description list.

Councilwoman McDonald also brought up about the sign out front that needed to be lettered again and the light in the parking lot that needs to be fixed. Supervisor Piazza will address these with Highway Superintendent Carlson before the next meeting.
