Dog Ordinance

The Town Board decided that the current Dog ordinance is sufficient for the Town of Kiantone we are a rural area, Dog Control Officer Harvey will handle all dog complaints case by case.

Parking Tickets

The Sheriff's Department has asked Highway Superintendent Carlson to have the Town get parking tickets printed so they can issue parking tickets and the majority of the revenue will stay in the Town, they cannot be written on the Uniform Traffic Violation forms that they have in use now. Supervisor Piazza directed the Town Clerk to find information online about getting tickets made. Highway Superintendent Carlson will check with Brocton to see what their tickets look like for an example.

Code Enforcement Procedures and Paperwork

The Town Board established the following procedures for permit money collected and Permits issued by Zoning Code Enforcement Officer.

The applicant is to come to the Kiantone Town Clerk's office and pick up the permit application to fill out at that time or return the filled out permit application to the Town Clerk's office.

The completed permit application will then be forwarded to the Code Enforcement Officer for approval and the amount of fees to be collected to be written on permit application.

The permit application with the fees to be collected will be forwarded to the Town Clerk's office, either by fax or a copy of the application.

The applicant will come to the Town Clerk's office to pay the appropriate fees and the Town Clerk will type up the permit granted sign to give the applicant and a copy will be forwarded to the Code Enforcement Officer. Supervisor Piazza made a motion to adopt this policy, seconded by Councilman Sturzenbecker. Yea-5 nay- 0. Carried.

Building Repairs Mr. Montagna from Montagna's has called trying to see who is responsible for fixing the sinkhole on Foote Avenue near their store. The Town Clerk had given them the phone number to contact the State Highway at 1-800- POTHOLE. The State was not concerned about it unless it is in the center of the highway. The Town has no jurisdiction to get it repaired. The town clerk has directed them to proper party for notification,
